What is Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema cream and what is it used for?

- **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream is intended for people suffering from mild or moderate hand and contact eczema symptoms. The product is a topical epidermal barrier damage repair accelerator for contact and hand eczema symptoms. In addition, the cream creates a barrier on the skin against polaric bacterial toxins and super antigens. It also moisturizes and replenishes the missing natural ceramide components of the skin.
- This product can be used to treat hand and contact eczema symptoms resulting from irritative and/or allergic substances.
- **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream is a dermatological product for the treatment of hand and contact eczema skin symptoms, such as itching, red spots, dry skin, scaling, erosions, excoriations, papulation and induration. The product comes in a cream to be applied on the body.
- **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream is recommended for patients with damaged skin caused by hand and contact eczema symptoms and for patients aiming to keep their improved skin condition under control. In case symptoms reappear, please apply **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream immediately for a faster recovery of your symptoms.
- **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream is dermatologically tested.

What you should know before applying Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema cream

- **The product can be used on any individual, 6 years of age and older. Use the product on children only under parental supervision.**
- **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream does not contain Corticosteroids, Calcineurin-inhibitors, artificial colouring, perfume and parabens.
- In severe cases, with hyper-acute symptoms of contact eczema, or in case of pregnancy, consult your general practitioner or dermatologist, before beginning the (re)application of **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream.
- No allergic reactions or adverse effects have been reported during or after the clinical testing of this product.
- No contraindications and/or cross-allergies have been reported during and/or after the clinical observation of the product.
- **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream does not cause rebound effects upon discontinuation of use. Except for a possible slight tingling sensation that may occur during the first few days of application (on patients with deep fissures) no other side effects have been reported to date. The product causes no thinning of the skin, easy bruising or photo allergic reactions.
- In case of combination of **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream with other treatments it is recommended, in order to avoid adverse effects (of these methods of treatment), to consult a general practitioner or dermatologist before starting the combination treatment with **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream.
- **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream does not stain clothing, colours the skin, or causes depigmentation of the skin.
- The use of **Dermalex** is toxicologically safe.



How to apply Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema cream

Always apply **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream following this Instruction Leaflet. If you have any doubt about these instructions for use, please consult your doctor or pharmacist.

Instructions for use:

- Carefully clean the affected skin with lukewarm water
- Apply a thin layer of the **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream onto the skin
- Repeat the application 2 to 3 times a day
- **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream can be used safely over long periods of time
- In case of extreme dryness or itching, choose a scentless hypoallergenic moisturizing cream to cover and soothe the affected area after the application of the **Dermalex** product

Important information

- During the first 2-3 days of application apply the cream on a damp skin.
- **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream is water-soluble. Therefore, always re-apply the cream after washing your hands, showering or bathing.
- Do not scratch your itchy skin! Keep your fingernails very short in order to prevent infection and irritation.
- Do not apply the cream on open wounds or open wounds that are the result of cracking or scratching the skin!
- Whenever possible wear loose clothing made of natural materials. Natural materials absorb perspiration, body secretions and oily lotions.
- Contact eczema is caused by physical contact with allergen(s) or irritant substance(s) in your (work) environment. The best method to avoid these symptoms is to avoid contact with these irritants and allergens. Consult your doctor to establish which substance(s) you are sensitive or allergic to.



- **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream is for external use only.
- Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact, rinse thoroughly with lukewarm water.
- Discontinue use and consult your doctor or dermatologist if lasting irritation or allergic reactions occur during or after the application.
- Keep out of the reach of children.

How to store Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema cream

- Store at room temperature.
- In order to guarantee its hypoallergenic qualities, the **Dermalex Repair Contact Eczema** cream contains the least possible preservatives and stabilisers.
- Do NOT expose **Dermalex** to a heating source or direct sunlight!
